The material for this book has been taken from the 2006 thesis *Frederick Kiesler TM's Art of This Century in New York 1942-1947 in the Context of the Twentieth Century Art Museum*. The prime objective was to establish why so few people remember *Art of This Century* which Kiesler designed for Peggy Guggenheim in 1942 and she ruthlessly closed in 1947.
