Mr Dalloway A Novella:

Mr. Dalloway Robin Lippincott, 1999 A virtuoso performance of postmodern daring *Mr Dalloway* offers a rich augmentation of Virginia Woolf's classic novel. It is June 29, 1927. Richard and Clarissa Dalloway's thirtieth anniversary and also a day of historical significance. Richard has arranged a surprise party for his wife. As he leaves their house in Westminster to buy flowers for the party, his thoughts turn to Robert Davies, Robbie, a young editor at Faber with whom he has been having an affair off and on for many years. Because of Richard's efforts to contain their relationship, Robbie has exposed their affair in a letter to Clarissa, who tells her husband that she understands. And today, Richard, despite his misgivings, finds himself on his way to Robbie's house, only to be shaken by the discovery that Robbie is not there. As does the Woolf novel, *Mr Dalloway* takes place within a single day, unfolding prismatically with a simultaneity of events. Clarissa walks in London and remembers her courtship with Richard; their daughter, Elizabeth, searches for answers about her eccentric history tutor; a somewhat mysterious and premature death; and a determined and drunken Robert Davies has decided to crash Richard's party dressed all in white satin, no less. As the novella moves toward its surprising climax, it revisits several of Woolf's celebrated characters: Sally Seton, now Lady Rosseter; Hugh Whitbread; Lady Bruton; while introducing new ones such as the Sapphist couple, Katherine Truelock and Eleanor Gibson; and the strange and beautiful Sasha Richardson. Imaginative and formally bold as it refracts Woolf's fiction to invent a story completely, Lippincott's own *Mr Dalloway* rides forward on waves of a masterfully complex and musical prose full of wit, linguistic verve, and startling imagery. Robin Lippincott is the author of *The Real True Angel*, a collection of short stories published in 1996 by Fleur de Lis Press. His fiction and nonfiction have appeared in *The New York Times Book Review*, *The American Voice*, *The Literary Review*, *Provincetown Arts*, and many other magazines. He was awarded fellowships to Yaddo in 1997 and 1998. Born and raised in the South, he has lived in Boston for twenty years.

This volume comprises sixteen essays preceded by an introductory chapter focusing on the diverse modalities of textual and more widely artistic transfer. Whereas the first *Rewriting/Reprising* volume, coordinated by C. Maisonnat and J. Paccaud-Huguet, its subversive potential is perceptible notably through its many attempts at emancipating the genre from the ideological fetters of gender. code she felt had degenerated in most cases into mere formalism She regarded Victorian morality as unrealistic and suspected those who professed it of hypocrisy Marder 47 Furthermore her living at a time when the hard won victories of the suffragettes and women war workers were slowly being translated into law and affecting social attitudes Dowling 105 made her particularly interested in the emancipation s cause and in many of her essays and articles Virginia Woolf questioned the traditional socially constructed gender roles

Ingersoll,2016-12-06 As the subtitle indicates this book has three majors concerns The first and most important concern is an examination of the film adaptations of Woolf s novels To the Lighthouse Orlando and Mrs Dalloway in the order the films were released This is the heart of the matter a fairly conventional effort to acknowledge film reviews as well as the criticism of academicians in film or literature as a starting point for a fresh view of these three film adaptations Since many film specialists prefer that no film ever be adapted from literary fiction and many literature specialists have similarly wished that their favorite novels had never been filmed the effort to mediate the two sides can be challenging Of the three films To the Lighthouse is the least successful tending toward the old Masterpiece Theater mode of attempting to be faithful to the source text to use the term of the film theorist Robert Stam but missing the essence of the novel Director Sally Potter s Orlando is cinematically the most venturesome and attractive although some Woolf readers condemn Potter s erasure of Woolf s intent to celebrate her affair with Vita Sackville West whose son Nigel Nicolson called Woolf s Orlando the longest and most charming love letter in literature Mrs Dalloway tends toward the Merchant Ivory style of treating literary masterworks indeed the film credits include a debt of gratitude to the producer director partnership and is generally carried by the star power of Vanessa Redgrave although it is difficult to imagine her having a crush on another young woman even at

eighteen The book s second concern is Woolf s interest in what she would call the cinema As a member of Bloomsbury she saw and participated in the discussion of the cinema especially avant garde films which she considered to be more the future of cinema than film adaptations upon which she heaped great scorn for their ravenous if not rapacious consumption of vulnerable literary fiction such as Leo Tolstoy s Anna Karenina Woolf specialists such as Leslie Hankins proclaim her one of the earliest and most significant British film theorists for the brilliant essay The Cinema 1925 as film was just beginning to establish itself as art and not merely popular entertainment The third concern is a complex effort to explore the David Hare Stephen Daldry film adaptation of Michael Cunningham s Pulitzer Prize winning novel The Hours an homage to Mrs Dalloway in which Virginia Woolf has a starring role as portrayed by Oscar winner Nicole Kidman The film and Kidman s prosthetic nose produced a violent division among the Woolfians who either commended its bringing legions of new readers to Mrs Dalloway and potentially to Woolf Mrs Dalloway becoming the best seller it could not have been in her lifetime or were outraged by the film s diminishment of probably the most important female British novelist of the 20th century Even Nobel Laureate Doris Lessing spoke out against the travesty of a novelist she considered a foremother of later 20th century writers
