



The design space is composed of explicitly defined design options that clarify the development process in a structured way in order to require less design effort. The feasibility of the methodology is demonstrated through three case studies with different levels of complexity and coverage. In addition, an empirical study is conducted with end users in order to measure the relative usability level provided by different design decisions.
