They learn language in the functional context provided by the film and concepts are reinforced by onscreen activities that help students verify their comprehension. The feature length film 102 minutes is divided into twelve episodes and each episode includes onscreen pre and post viewing activities that make the film more accessible to students on both a linguistic and cultural level. Episodes are approximately fifteen to twenty minutes in length and correspond to the chapters in the textbook. Three and a half hours of viewing allow intermediate students to explore the richness of French language and culture. By hearing French spoken with a variety of accents and at different speeds in the film students will gain confidence in their ability to understand authentic spoken French.
