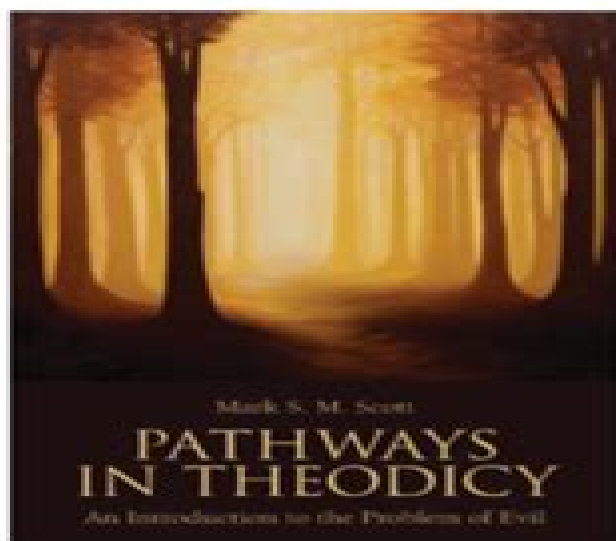

Why does God permit senseless suffering? If God is good and all-powerful, why does evil exist? The problem of evil perennially vexes theology, but many theologians have abandoned the project of theodicy, or the theological explanation of evil, as either fruitless or hopeless. Academic studies on theodicy, moreover, typically succumb to theological deficiency and abstraction, often devoid of any concrete connection to Christian life and practice. In *Pathways in Theodicy*, designed for students and scholars alike, Mark S. M. Scott reinigorates stalled debates in philosophy and theology through a detailed reassessment of the problem of evil and the task of theodicy and through a careful analysis of the major models and motifs in theodicy. Scott explores the strengths and weaknesses of classic and contemporary perspectives on the problem of evil and invites readers to assess the cogency and relevance of each on their own. Rather than promoting a single perspective, *Pathways in Theodicy* explores the plurality of options available to treat the problem of evil and the provisional and tentative nature of theodicy, which searches not for final, definitive solutions but for viable ways to move the conversation forward.

Theology and the Problem of Evil Kenneth Surin, 2004-10-29 One of the most profound problems that theologians are called on to address is the presence of evil and suffering in the world and how this can be reconciled with the assertion of an omnipotent and morally perfect God This book begins by showing how the problem of evil has been inextricably bound up with the problematic deity created by the philosophical theism of the Enlightenment and perpetuated ever since demonstrating how contemporary theodiscists have failed to perceive the historical and cultural determinants which affect their theorizing Dr Surin argues that thinking on the problem of evil consists of two fundamental perspectives He labels these the theoretical and the practical approaches and examines the work of a number of theologians who typify each Alvin Plantinga Richard Swinburne the process theologians and John Hick exemplify the theoretical approach Dorothee Soelle Jurgen Moltmann and P T Forsyth the practical He uses the views of Dostoevsky s character Ivan Karamazov and the protagonists in Elie Wiesel s writing as a paradigm for evaluating the two approaches and concludes that only the practical approach has the merit of both rooting itself in the realities of human suffering and grounding itself in the fundamental rule of what he calls an adequate grammar of salvation namely that God justifies himself by justifying sinners on the cross Finally Dr Surin explores this grammar of the notion of an incarnate salvation with particular reference to the need for a messianic and practical solidarity with those who are afflicted This thought provoking book will serve both as an introduction to those new to the ideas of theodicy and as a stimulating essay for those dissatisfied with conventional studies of theology and the problem of evil
