The Gospel According to Matthew

Authorship: Unknown

Place of Composition: Probably Antioch

Purpose: A comprehensive collection of Jesus' ethical teachings, which provides a behavioral guide for the disciples (Greek for "church").

Key Theme(s): Presents Jesus' life in terms of fulfilling prophecies from the Old Testament, stresses his credentials as Israel's true Messiah.

Authorship: Unknown

Place of Composition: Most likely Syria or Palestine

Purpose: Presents Jesus as a "hidden" messiah, misunderstood by his disciples and the general public.

Key Theme(s): Jesus as an apocalyptic figure; his ministry heralds the end of the world.

The Gospel According to Luke

Authorship: Unknown, though some contemporary writers list Luke "the beloved physician" as its author.

Place of Composition: Probably Ephesus.

Purpose: Presents Jesus' career as the prelude to an indefinitely extended historical process.

Key Theme(s): God acts through Jesus and his church to effect human salvation; Jesus' Kingdom (the demands radical cultural/religious change in society's values).

The Gospel According to John

Authorship: Unknown, though late second century Christians attributed the book to John, the son of Zebedee.

Place of Composition: Probably Ephesus, though some scholars favor Palestine or Syria.

Purpose: Clarify the relationship between theology and chronology in the gospel.

Key Theme(s): Jesus is the embodiment of heavenly Wisdom; crucifixion was not a defeat, but a glorification leading Jesus to return to heaven.

- II. The "book of signs" (2:1-11:57)
- III. The "book of glory" (12:1-20:31)
 - The last supper, farewell discourse (13:1-17:26)

- IV. Epilogue: (21:1-23) Some commentators treat this passage not as an appendix/second ending.

Acts

Authorship: Unknown, also wrote the Gospel According to Luke.

Place of Composition: Probably Ephesus.

Purpose: Shows Christianity as a spontaneous faith for all people.

Key Theme(s): Themes are divided into two parts.

- (1) The original Jerusalem church, the power of Pentecost, the church's conflict with Jewish leadership, expansion into Antioch and Samaria.
- (2) Missionary journeys of Paul.

Structure:

- I. Prologue, the ascension (1:1-11)
- II. Founding the Jerusalem church (1:12-2:47)
- III. Ministry of Peter and the Apostles (3:1-5:42)
