The role of museums in creating and maintaining both cultural identities and their stereotypes is an area of debate and discourse in both archaeology and museology. Despite the long history of the collection and public display of Islamic material, there has been no systematic research into either its representation or into public perceptions of these representations. This programme of research represents the first such study of the representation of Islamic material culture in British museums. This commences with the discussion and evaluation of the history of contact between the Islamic world and Europe in general and Britain in particular. Given the role played by museums in the construction of identity, the questions underpinning this are firstly: what are the messages they receive about the world of Islam, and secondly: what do these displays say about the Islamic world, past and present.
