All factors of character strengths correlated with life satisfaction, with emotional/spiritual strengths being the highest. Women had higher scores on emotional/spiritual strengths, whereas men had higher scores on intellectual strengths. Higher age was associated with higher scores on emotional/spiritual strengths and higher life satisfaction.
