AuthorHouse done a self publication of the book Many changes have taken place since the journey was completed and the manuscript written **A Modern Pilgrim in Mecca** Arthur John Byng Wavell, 1918 Major Arthur John Byng Wavell 1882 1916 was a British military officer Arabist and a fellow of the Royal Geographical Society Born in London he was educated at Winchester College and Sandhurst In 1900 he joined the Welsh Regiment of the British Army and sailed to British South Africa where he fought in the Boer War This was followed by a War Office assignment to map and report on less known British possessions in the region during which he journeyed across the Kalahari Desert to Victoria Falls He left the military service in 1906 He then went to British East Africa where he bought land in Nyali now a suburb of Mombasa Kenya It was here that he began a sisal plantation learned Arabic and conceived of the idea of visiting the forbidden Mohammedan City of Mecca in disguise **A Modern Pilgrim in Mecca** recounts Wavell's pilgrimage to Muslim holy sites in present day Saudi Arabia in 1908-9 Travelling on a Turkish passport and disguised as a Zanzibari by the name of Ali bin Mohammed Wavell first left London for Marseille where he met with his two Muslim companions a Mombasa based Zanzibari and a Berlin based Syrian From Genoa they boarded a ship to Alexandria and later to Beirut and from there they took the train to Damascus where they stayed for a month before taking the Hejaz Railway to Medina A caravan from Medina took them to the port town of Yanbu on the Red Sea and then by ship to Jeddah and overland to Mecca The book begins with a prelude on Wavell's background written by Major Leonard Darwin who was president of the Royal Geographical Society This is followed by a preface and a lengthy introduction both by Wavell on the history and geography of Arabia and Islam The rest of the book is divided into sections discussing each leg of the journey including descriptions of the cities he visited and the people he encountered The book concludes with a description of the hajj pilgrimage rituals and the city of Mecca Following the hajj Wavell traveled extensively in the Middle East In 1914 he raised in Mombasa a force of about 150 Arab street water carriers the so called Arab Rifles or Wavell's Arabs to defend the city against the Germans Although he was credited with saving the city from falling into enemy hands he was severely wounded in the fight Two years later he was ambushed and killed near the post of Mwele in a skirmish with the Germans as he and his men were guarding the Uganda Railway Shown here is the second edition of Wavell's book published posthumously in 1918 [With the pilgrims to Mecca: The great pilgrimage of A.H. 1319; A.D. 1902](#) Wilfrid Sparroy, Hadji Khan, 2022-08-21 [With the pilgrims to Mecca: The great pilgrimage of A.H. 1319; A.D. 1902](#) stands as an exemplary collection that illuminates the profound spiritual journey of the Hajj through a rich tapestry of narratives These accounts brimming with diverse literary styles capture the essence of one of Islam's five pillars from poignant personal perspectives to broader cultural observations The anthology excels in conveying the immense significance of this religious pilgrimage embedding the reader deeply in the multitude of experiences emotions and reflections it induces Through vivid storytelling and analytical discourse the collection traverses not just a geographical journey but also explores the depths of faith community and individual transformation The contributions from Wilfrid Sparroy and Hadji Khan each

decided to go on the Hajj Daughter of the distinguished Scottish explorer Lord Dunmore granddaughter of the Earl of Leicester and great niece of the notorious romantic Lady Jane Digby el Mezrab the young Evelyn Murray had spent childhood winters in North Africa There she had been imbued with the Muslim way of life becoming as she puts it a little Muslim at heart Before and after the First World War she travelled widely in Egypt Syria and Transjordan While strongly drawn to the Arab world she maintained a conventional place in society at home marrying the wealthy John Cobbold in 1891 and devoting herself to her Suffolk house and Scottish estate her gardens and especially deer stalking in the Highlands of which she was a renowned exponent When her husband by then High Sheriff of Suffolk died in 1929 Lady Evelyn decided to perform the pilgrimage Arriving at Jiddah by steamer from Suez in February 1933 she stayed with the Philbys and entered into the life of Jiddah's foreign community while waiting to obtain permission to perform the Hajj In doing so she had to overcome the considerable suspicion surrounding foreign converts who Muslims felt made the pilgrimage and then wrote about it as a dangerous and sensational adventure While in Jiddah she received visits from various officials of the royal court notably the King's son the Amir Faysal later King Faysal PILGRIMAGE TO MECCA is as much an account of an interior journey of faith as a conventional travelogue It takes the form of a day by day journal interspersed with digressions on the history and merits of Islam While awaiting permission to go to Makkah she was allowed to travel to Madinah of which she gives an enchanting account She is the first English writer to give a first hand description of the life of the women's quarters of the households in which she stayed in Madinah Makkah and Muna an account remarkable for its sympathy and vividness Her book was published in 1934 to favourable reviews but has never until now been reprinted This new edition with a biographical introduction by William Facey and Lady Evelyn's great great niece Miranda Taylor serves to rescue this unique and intriguing Anglo Muslim from the neglect that has since befallen her even among scholars specialising in women travellers
