Lucas and Ryan are working on a construction project for school. Lucas's wooden board is 5 times the length of Ryan's board. If Ryan's wooden board is 3 feet, how long is Lucas's wooden board?



$5 \times 3 = 15 \rightarrow$ Lucas's board is 15 feet long.
