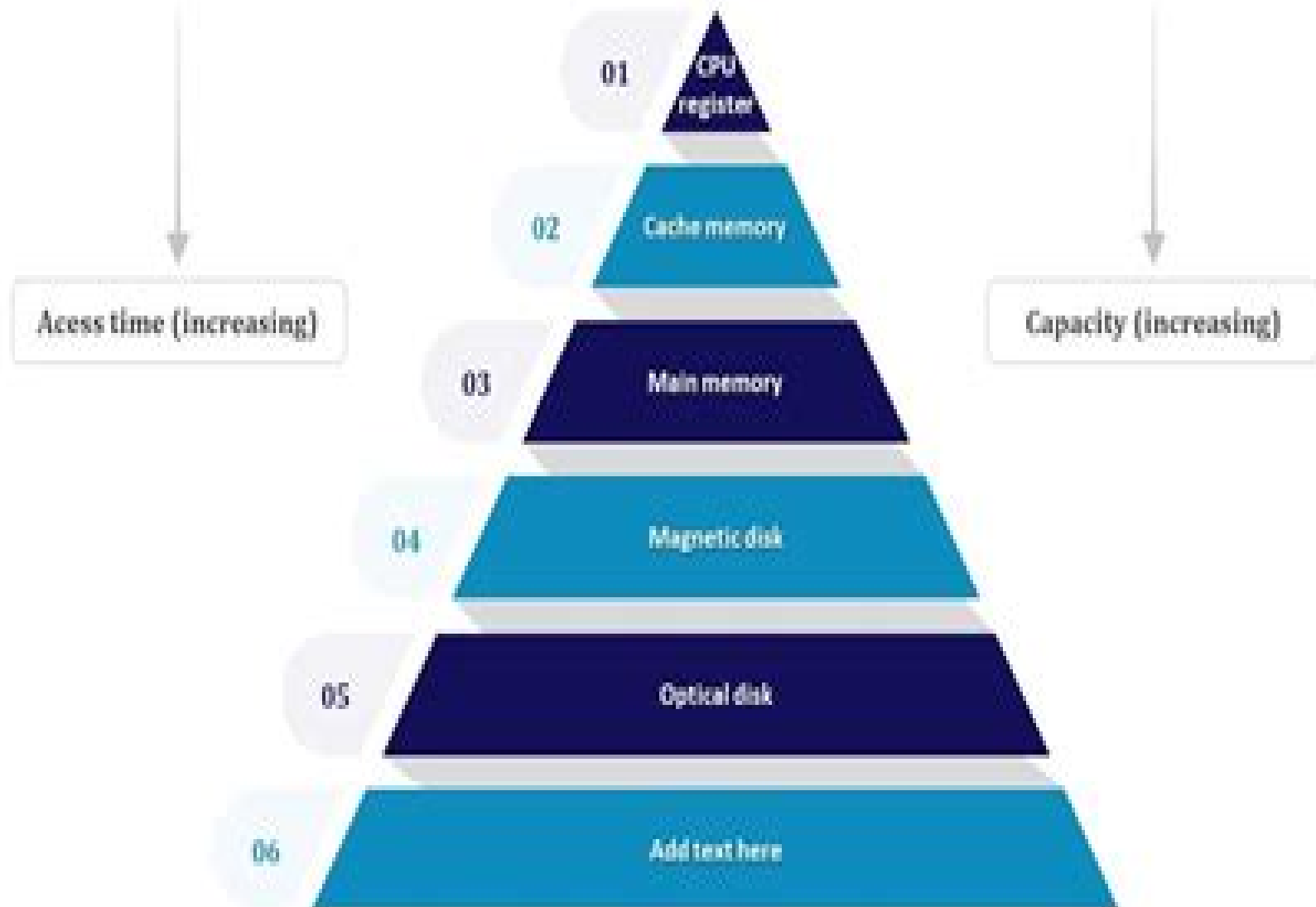


Memory hierarchy design in computer architecture
