2. Marginalized groups can find it harder to articulate themselves.
3. Marginalized groups have to translate their thoughts before speaking.

EXAMPLE

Kramarae (1981) argues that women are often linguistically subordinated to men.

Women are defined in relation to their husbands (Mrs. X), historically take their husbands' surnames, and tend to be referred to as "Harold's wife" rather than as having their own autonomous identity.
