read or heard about in an area of science By creating displays or collections of scientific information or demonstrating certain natural phenomena the student goes through a process similar to a library research report or a meta analysis in any other subject Projects of this type may be appropriate for some students at a very early level but they usually do not provide the experiences that develop problem solving skills related to the scientific process On the other hand experimental projects pose a question or hypothesis which is then answered by doing an experiment or by modeling a phenomenon The question doesn't have to be something never before answered by scientist that is not necessary to conduct original research The process of picking a topic designing an experiment and recording and analyzing data is what's important **Science**
