On March 15, 2011, Donald Trump changed television forever. To trace these unfulfilled promises and flopped ideas, Barker draws upon a unique mix of personal Social TV experiences and curated archives of material that were intentionally marginalized amid pivots to the next big thing. Multi-screen campaigns have shifted away from a focus on live TV and toward all-day content streams.
