40°	Type I	Organic matter levels are very low, indicating soil has been greatly altered over time to become almost inert. Little humus or organic matter remains.	Large amounts of salts, limestone, clay, and gravel.
50°	Type II	Organic matter is very low, but soil has not been greatly altered over time.	Small amounts of salts, limestone, clay, and gravel.
60°	Type III	Organic matter levels are very high, indicating soil has not been greatly altered over time.	Fresh organic materials.

What is caused by geographical distribution?

The number of different soil types in a given location is determined by the climate and the parent material.

Type of distribution	Picture of this distribution	Why are these positions?
Homogeneous		SOIL CLASSIFICATION: Salinity, limestone, silt, sand, gravel, iron, and organic matter are all negligible.
Heterogeneous		SOIL CLASSIFICATION: Soil grain size varies, soil chemistry.
Disjunctive		SOIL CLASSIFICATION: Soil conditions fluctuate from high organic content to high mineral content.
