

TYPES OF ORGANIZED CRIME

When it comes to organized crime, how do you distinguish between groups? In its latest *Serious and Organised Crime Threat Assessment (SOCTA)*, Europol identified four key indicators for groups.

These identifiers, however, are not hard and fast rules for how groups could be differentiated; nearly two-thirds of the criminal groups analyzed in the 2021 SOCTA were composed of members of different nationalities.
