By supplying a reader with a universal idea such as beauty, truth, or goodness, the writer of a study guide facilitates the reader's understanding of the author's purpose in writing.

Man, with this plumb line in mind, was expected to judge his own creations by the judgment God pronounced on His own creation. For the sake of brevity, we have selected 14 ideas in which to focus our study.

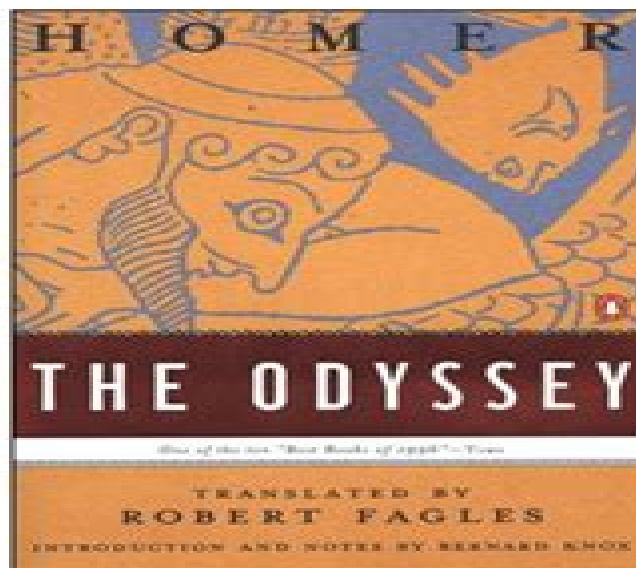

About the Book

The Odyssey is the second of Homer's famous epic poems and, like *The Iliad*, is a classic of western literature. In the Greek, "Odusseia" simply means "the story of Odysseus. Within it we are presented with the twists and turns of Odysseus' journey as he struggles to reach his homeland after the Trojan War. Many familiar elements can be found in Odysseus' adventures. Nearly everyone is familiar on some level with his adventures with the Cyclops and the difficult choice made between the Clashing Rocks and the cliffs where Scylla lurked (the literal rock and a hard place). After ten years of trials such as these and after losing all of his men to one threat or another, Odysseus finally makes it home, only to find that he now

faces his greatest threat of all. A pack of suitors, bent on marrying his wife and taking over his throne, has amassed itself within his walls, also plotting the death of his only son.

The Odyssey assumes the audience's knowledge of the Greeks ten-year battle with Troy over the return of Helen to her husband, Menelaus. In addition, it also assumes the audience's knowledge of a few other events that took place after *The Iliad* left off, such as the death of Achilles. These events would have been familiar to ancient audiences, but have mostly been lost to us, except in pieces and summaries. Brief descriptions of these "lost" epics that are pertinent to the story can be found in the side notes for each book.
