The response of firms to this phenomenon in the search ecosystem has appeared in different forms, varying from counterfeiting to engaging based on the role of corporate in the ecosystem. Although myriad research has been convened in this area of research, yet still not much is known about the role of product reviews in consumer decision process other than contribution of star rating in sales. This ostensible feature of research on product reviews' effect can be attributed to the perplexity of text mining.
