define their political behavior within the terms set by maternalism Instead they used liberal arguments of equality justice and democratic citizenship to argue for their right to speak frankly about American policy Such claims while often in opposition to strategies outlined by their defense teams helped form the framework for modern arguments made in defense of civil liberties
