The book opens with two theoretical essays on the subject of subversive tendencies and myth reinvention in the contemporary novel. From there it moves on to the analysis of essential texts. Firstly classical myths in works by authors such as Andr  Gide, Thomas Pynchon, Julio Cort zar, Italo Calvino or Christa Wolf for instance. Theseus, Oedipus or Medea are discussed. Then myths of biblical origin such as the Flood or the Golem are revisited in the work of Giorgio Bassani, Julian Barnes and Cynthia Ozick. A further section is concerned with the place of modern myths: Faust, the ghost, Ophelia in the fiction of G nter Grass, Paul Auster or Clara Jan s. The contributors have also delved into the relationship between myth and art, especially in the discourse of contemporary advertising, painting and cinema, and myth s intercultural dimensions, hybridity in the Latin American novels of Augusto Roa Bastos and Carlos Fuentes, and in the Hindu-themed novels of Bharati Mukherjee. This volume emerges from the careful selection of 37 essays out of over 200 which were put forward by outstanding scholars from 25 different countries for the Madrid International Conference on Myth and Subversion, March 2011.
