Transmitting stories through cable or couriers remained expensive and often required the cooperation of foreign governments and the American armed forces. Initially reporters from a neutral America documented the early victories by Nazi Germany and the Soviet invasion of Finland. Not all journalists strove for objectivity. During her time reporting from Ireland Helen Kirkpatrick remained a fierce critic of that country's neutrality. Once the United States joined the fight after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor American journalists supported the struggle against the Axis powers but this volume will show that reporters even when members of the army sponsored newspaper Stars and Stripes were not mere ciphers of the official line. African American reporters Roi Ottley and Ollie Stewart worked to bolster the morale of Black GIs and undermined the institutional racism endemic to the American war effort. Women front line reporters are given their due in this volume examining the struggles to overcome gender bias by describing triumphs of Thérèse Mabel Bonney, Iris Carpenter, Lee Carson and Anne Stringer. The line between public relations and journalism could be a fine one as reflected by the U.S. Marine Corps creating its own network of Marine correspondents who reported on the Pacific island campaigns and had their work published by American media outlets. Despite the pressures of censorship the best American reporters strove for accuracy in reporting the facts even when dependent on official communiqués issued by the military. Many wartime reporters even when covering major turning points

sought to embrace a reporting style that recorded the experiences of average soldiers Often associated with Ernie Pyle and Bill Mauldin the embrace of the human interest story served as one of the enduring legacies of the conflict Despite the importance of American war reporting in shaping perceptions of the war on the home front as well as shaping the historical narrative of the conflict this work underscores how there is more to learn Readers will gain from this work a new appreciation of the contribution of American journalists in writing the first version of history of the global struggle against Nazi Germany imperial Japan and fascist Italy

Stalin believed that an international trial for Nazi war criminals was the best way to show the world the sacrifices his country had made to defeat Hitler and he together with his legal mouthpiece Andrei Vyshinsky maintained tight control over Soviet representatives during talks leading up to the creation of the Nuremberg IMT trial in 1945 and the trial itself. But Soviet prosecutors at Nuremberg were unable to deal comfortably with the complexities of an open western style legal proceeding which undercut their effectiveness throughout the trial. However they were able to present a significant body of evidence that underscored the brutal nature of Hitler's racial war in Russia from 1941-45 a theme which became central to Stalin's efforts to redefine international criminal law after the war. Bryan Mark Rigg, 2002 On the murderous road to racial purity Hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding Jewish identity. After centuries of Jewish assimilation and intermarriage in German society he discovered that eliminating Jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he'd anticipated. As Bryan Rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the German military. Contrary to conventional views Rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of German military men were classified by the Nazis as Jews or partial Jews Mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s. Rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals. As Rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves Jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived German nation. In turn they had been embraced by the Wehrmacht which prior to Hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers. The process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of Nazi law. Numerous exemptions were made in order to allow a soldier to stay within the ranks or to spare a soldier's parent spouse or other relative from incarceration or far worse. Hitler's own signature can be found on many of these exemption orders. But as the war dragged on Nazi politics came to trump military logic even in the face of the Wehrmacht's growing manpower needs closing legal loopholes and making it virtually impossible for these soldiers to escape

the fate of millions of other victims of the Third Reich Based on a deep and wide ranging research in archival and secondary sources as well as extensive interviews with more than four hundred Mischlinge and their relatives Rigg's study breaks truly new ground in a crowded field and shows from yet another angle the extremely flawed dishonest demeaning and tragic essence of Hitler's rule
