countertransference to trauma so as to be fully present with their clients and consistently able to confront abuse patterns in society. The object relations approach not only deals with trauma's impact on the individual but views it in its cultural and interpersonal context as well. Society alternately emphasizes and ignores trauma so that an encapsulated traumatic experience festers until the next eruption just as dissociative defenses segmentally protect and exaggerate traumatic experience in the individual case. They resuscitate Freud's seduction hypothesis and the traumatic basis of the repetition compulsion.
