## Heart Failure

### Patho

Regardless of the etiology, the pathophysiology of heart failure results in similar changes and clinical manifestations. Significant myocardial dysfunction such as ischemic heart disease, hyperthyroidism, myocardial infarction, valve disease, alcohol, cocaine abuse, and hypertension. In turn causes decrease cardiac output, systemic blood pressure, and perfusion to kidneys.

### Right Sided Heart Failure

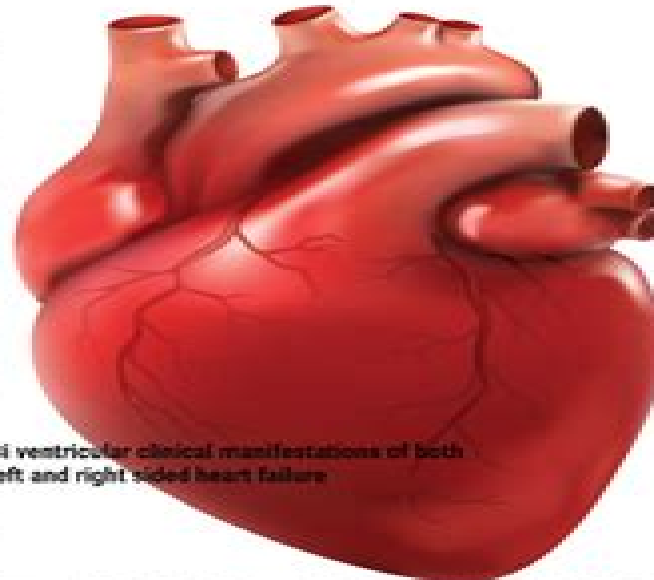
#### Clinical Manifestations

Fatigue, ascites, hepatosplenomegaly, distended jugular veins, anorexia, weight gain, dependent edema

### Left Sided Heart Failure

#### Clinical Manifestations

Paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea, restlessness, confusion, orthopnea, tachycardia, exertional dyspnea, fatigue, cyanosis, pulmonary congestion



Bi ventricular clinical manifestations of both left and right sided heart failure

### Diagnostic Testing

Echocardiogram, chest x-ray, electrocardiogram, BUN, CBC, BNP, creatinine, liver function

### Potential NANDA Nursing Diagnoses

Activity intolerance associated with decreased CO, Hypervolaemia associated with the HF syndrome, Anxiety associated with clinical manifestations of HF, Powerlessness associated with chronic illness and hospitalizations, Impaired family ability to manage regime

### Medications for Heart Failure

Loop diuretics, thiazide diuretics, aldosterone antagonists, ACE inhibitors, ARBs, ARNI, Beta Blockers, Ivabradine, Hydralazine-isosorbide dinitrate, digitalis, IV dopamine, IV dobutamine, IV milrinone, vasodilators
