Position for administering ear drops -

correct answer - Position patient on side with treatment ear facing up

- For adults: pull pinna up and back
- For children < 3 y/o: pull pinna down and back
- Patient should stay on side with treatment ear facing up for 5-10 minutes after administration and apply pressure to tragus

Precaution for enteral feeding tubes -

correct answer Flush with 15-30 ml of water before and after each medication to ensure patency

IM injections -

correct answer 90 degree angle

1-1.5 inch needle

SQ injections -

correct answer 45 degree angle

5/8 inch needle
