INTRODUCTION TO JAVA

A PROGRAM is a set of instructions a computer can execute to perform a task.

SYNTAX are rules that specify the basic vocabulary of a programming language, and states what can and cannot be used.

SEMANTICS refer to the meaning of a program. It's the way that the code behaves and the rules that govern how it operates.

COMMENTS are ignored by the computer. They are for human readers only. To make a single comment, use // to make many comments across multiple lines, use /* (starts with and ends with) */.

COMMANDS are statements that can be executed by a computer to accomplish a small subset of possible actions. An action can be completed in class and its possible actions and requests. Classes can be used to add a new type to the Java language.

SYSTEMS are objects that can be used to interact with the Java language.

CLASSES is a program or class that can be created by a programmer to represent a small subset of possible actions. An action can be completed in class and its possible actions and requests. Classes can be used to add a new type to the Java language.

STRINGS, OBJECTS, ENUMS AND SUBROUTINES

ENUM is a class that can be created by a programmer to represent a small subset of possible actions. An action can be completed in class and its possible actions and requests. Classes can be used to add a new type to the Java language.

SUBROUTINES in Java, every subroutine is contained in a class or in an object. Some classes that are contained within the Java language contain predefined subroutines that you can use. These subroutines are subroutines that can be used to manipulate that class. Subroutines are also known as methods. These subroutines are "built-in" to the Java language. A subroutine is a "Procedure" which can be used without knowing what goes on inside.

CLASSES Classes in Java have two different functions.

1. A class can group together variables and information contained in that class. This group is called static members of the class.
2. Classes are used to describe objects. Meaning, the class of an object identifies what subroutines and variables are contained in that object.

SUBROUTINE EXAMPLE: `System.out.println`

The subroutine is used to display information to the user. `System.out.println("Hello World")` outputs the message "Hello World". `System` is one of Java's standard classes. `out` is one of the static members contained in this class. This subroutine `println` refers to an object, and this object has methods or subroutines of its own. `"HelloWorld"` is a compound identifier or, code that refers to the "HelloWorld" method (subroutine) within the "out" object of the "System" class.
