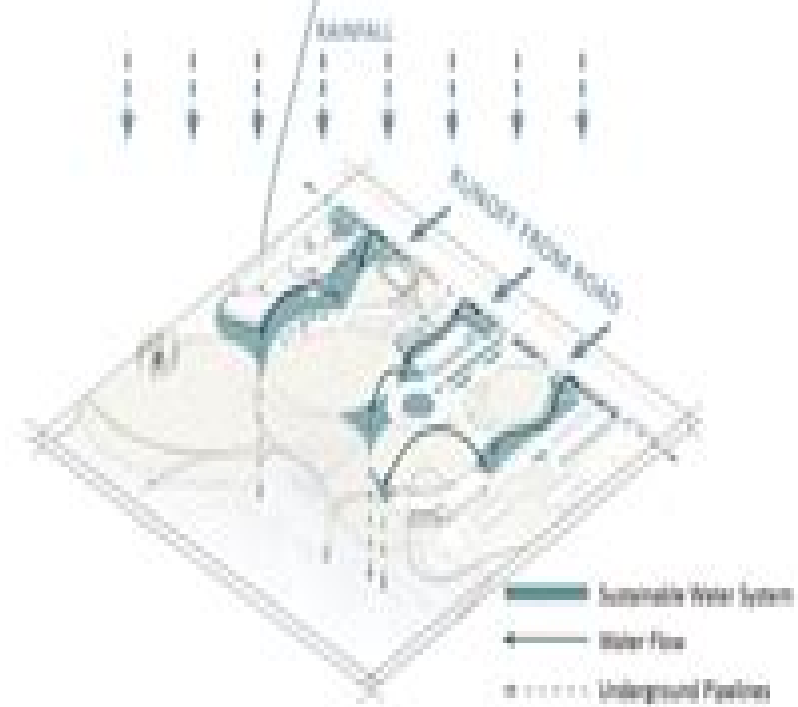




PLANTING DESIGN
