Concomitantly, research on autism and psychopathy attests to the neurobiological basis of psychopathologies in which stable impairments of mentalizing are most conspicuous. In development and in psychotherapy, mentalizing begets mentalizing as exemplified by a mentalizing stance that fosters inquisitiveness and curiosity about mental states in oneself and others. Basic principles and clinical examples including the use of transference demonstrate the spirit and technique of mentalizing capped off by a patient's first-hand account of mentalization-based treatment for borderline personality disorder. Attachment trauma is the wellspring of disrupted mentalizing capacity and a focus on mentalizing provides an integrative framework for psychodynamic and cognitive behavioral treatment of trauma as well as for parenting, family, and social systems interventions directed toward interrupting the perpetuation of trauma in relationships. Psychoeducational interventions including patient education and structured exercises are employed to cultivate a therapeutic alliance around mentalizing.
