but Brabantio leaves saying that Desdemona will betray Othello By order of the Duke Othello leaves Venice to command the Venetian armies against invading Turks on the island of Cyprus accompanied by his new wife his new lieutenant Cassio his ensign Iago and Iago's wife Emilia as Desdemona's attendant
