Yegin Genc,Jie Ren,2017 While many consumers rely heavily on online reviews during their purchases it is unrealistic to expect a consumer to read every online review and make an informed decision Many online review systems provide summary views in the form of overall sentiment scores or rating distributions e g Amazon Alibaba etc While consumers rely on such high level views that summarize the opinions of many they also read individual reviews to understand the nature of the overall sentiment In a way product details overall sentiment summaries and individual reviews form a network of information that users explore to make their purchase decisions This work studies the user behavior when they are exploring this

network of product and sentiment information and how it may relate to online sales

Online Consumer Reviews

Hessamedin Vali, 2016 Consumer reviews as an important source of product information are becoming popular in online markets. Due to lack of physical access to the product and variation among buyer preferences there is always the risk of selecting an inappropriate product that doesn't meet a customer's needs. If this happens not only does the buyer face an uncomfortable situation but also the seller will be in jeopardy of losing potential customers as well as paying warranty-related costs and expenses. In the second chapter the focus is on different types of conflicting information among reviews as factors that affect their informativeness and accuracy of a purchasing decision. Cognitive load theory explains that when a type of review conflict is easy to capture but cannot be related to a product like a conflicting star rating the cognitive load is too low and the product information cannot be captured. Conflicting attributes can be easily related to a product and they are easy to capture therefore the cognitive load is medium and the delivered information is high. In the third chapter the focus is on the effect of a review's repeating purchase cues on the overall perceived value of the product. In summary when a positive review includes repeating purchase cues positive reviews are perceived more helpful than negative reviews. Finally the value of review dimensions and review format on the review's perceived value is studied. In general comparison reviews are perceived to be more valuable than noncomparison reviews. However in the field of consumer reviews comparing reviews provides too much information and overwhelms the potential buyer. By categorizing information in a table format the overwhelming issue can be managed so comparing reviews in a table format is perceived more valuable than existing traditional reviews.

Large-Scale Cross-Category Analysis of Consumer Review Content and Sales Conversion Leveraging Deep Learning Xiao Liu, 2019 How consumers use review content in their decision making has remained a black box due to the labor intensive nature of extracting content from review text and the lack of data on review reading behavior. In this study we overcome this challenge by applying deep learning based natural language processing on a comprehensive dataset that tracks individual level review reading, searching and purchasing behaviors on an e-commerce site to investigate how consumers use review content. We extract quality and price content from more than 500 000 reviews spanning nearly 600 product categories. We achieve two objectives. First we describe consumers' review content reading behaviors. We find that although consumers do not read review content all the time they do rely on review content for products that are expensive or of uncertain quality. Second we quantify the causal impact of content of read reviews on sales. We use a regression discontinuity in time design and leverage the variation in the review content seen by consumers due to newly added reviews. To extract content we use supervised deep learning techniques that identify six theory driven content dimensions. We find that aesthetics and price content in the reviews significantly affects conversion across almost all product categories. Review content has a higher impact on sales when the average rating is higher and the variance of ratings is lower. Consumers depend more on review content when the market is more competitive, immature or when brand information is not easily accessible. A counterfactual
