

local areas The magnitude of technology spillovers hinges on local firms absorptive capacities and their technological connections to the multinationals Chapter 2 co authored with Rui Xu analyzes the impact of rising import competition from China on U S innovative activities Using Compustat data we find that import competition induces R D expenditures to be reallocated towards more productive and more profitable firms within each industry Such reallocation effect has the potential to offset the average drop in firm level R D identified in the previous literature Indeed our quantitative analysis shows no adverse impact of import competition on aggregate R D expenditures Taking the analysis beyond manufacturing we find that import competition has led to reallocation of researchers towards booming service industries including business and repairs personal and financial services Chapter 3 co authored with Constantine Yannelis introduces a new measure of firm level regulation We find that more regulation increases labor and capital inputs Productivity decreases which is consistent with a model of regulation inducing non productive investment We employ two empirical strategies to identify the causal impact of regulation on firms first utilizing structural breaks and industry level regulation changes and second computing predicted industry level regulation measures as instruments We conduct an event study using the surprise 2016 US election results Firms with higher Dodd Frank exposure exhibited higher returns following an increase in the probability of repeal
