manuscript draws parallels between the language used by the Bulgarian and the British media thus providing a similar starting point as the majority of the potential readers are probably more familiar with the latter In addition scholars working extensively with other local cultures and or media and resorting to English as a medium for the popularization of their research can use the presented analytical frame to their specific analyses and contribute even further to the enrichment of the global data base on the topic
