relationships and ensure understanding to all stakeholders Olivier notes that he wanted to write Organisational Design to provide an entry point into this body of knowledge because he believes Jaques's work has been unfairly marginalized due to its incompatibility with other organizational design theories One detractor quoted here notes that any theory not open to inclusion with existing theories is doomed to expulsion from the academic ranks Standing on its own Jaques's seven work levels providing a map for building an organization's personnel structure is indeed useful And Olivier's table on page 27 breaking down each level's goals and Suggested timeframe is worth reviewing But while his enthusiasm for both the model and man are apparent Olivier generally fails to dissect the complicated approach in a manner that will be accessible for those unfamiliar with Jaques's work His book may be valuable for advanced organizational psychologists but is not recommended for novice and intermediate design specialists Blueink Review
