Emilia - **ANS** Mistress to Desdemona. She is very committed to Desdemona. Wife of Iago. She doesn't know what her husband is doing. She is killed by her husband.

Bianca - **ANS** In a dirty/naughty relationship with Cassio.

Lodovico - **ANS** Kinsman of Brabantio. Similar to an uncle to Desdemona. His role in the play is a letter bearer from the council in Venice to Othello in Cyprus.

Montano - **ANS** Captain of the guard in Cyprus. Helps take down Cassio.

Venice - **ANS** The original setting of the play. This is where Brabantio lives. This is the first place where we see the characters. The characters are from Venice. They make their plan to attack while here.
