

### Hemodynamic Monitoring:

- Monitors the effectiveness of therapy and guides treatment
- Used as a guide for fluid resuscitation, measures pressure, flow and oxygenation of the cardiovascular system

### Assessment of Circulation:

- **Neuro:**
  - LOC/AMS (altered mental status), confusion, feeling of doom
- **Cardiac:**
  - **MAP =  $2 \times \text{diastolic} + \text{systolic} / 3$**
  - A systolic BP < 90 or MAP < 65 NEEDS to be addressed (indicates decreased tissue and organ perfusion)
  - High MAP indicated increased cardiac workload
  - **Normal: 70-110**
  - **Pulse Pressure (PP):**
    - Difference between Systolic BP and Diastolic BP
    - **Normal is 40-60**
    - Narrow = shock state or HF
    - **Wide = increased ICP, may occur during exercise or in atherosclerosis**
- **Pulmonary:**
  - Abnormal or adventitious breath sounds
- **GI:**
  - Hypoactive or absent bowel sound
  - Nausea/ vomiting
  - Paralytic ileus
- **Renal:**
  - Urine output less 0.5 mL/kg/hr (average 30mL/hr)
- **Integumentary:**
  - Cap refill > 3 seconds
  - Diminished or absent or pulses
  - Cold, clammy, cyanotic
  - Peripheral edema

### 4 Basic parameters of hemodynamics:

#### 1. Preload (Volume)

- Involves the amount of blood that fills the ventricles during diastole
- Increased in: hypervolemia, HF, regurgitation of cardiac valves, renal failure, CHF
- **Left Sided Preload:**
  - **Pressure Readings:**
  - **Pulmonary Artery Wedge Pressure (PAWP)**
    - Reflects LV filling/ left ventricular diastolic pressure
    - Obtained via pulmonary cath. Swan Ganz/ **PA** catheter when balloon is inflated it reflect the pressure of the **(PAWP)**
    - **Normal PAWP 6-12 mmHg**
    - 15-18 mmHg indicates LV failure
    - Low values = hypovolemia/fluid volume deficit
    - High values = hypervolemia/fluid volume overload or LV failure
    - 18-20: onset of pulmonary congestion
