TYPES OF ORGANIZED CRIME

When it comes to organized crime, how do you distinguish between groups? In its latest Serious and Organised Crime Threat Assessment (SOCTA),

Europol identified four key indicators for groups.

These identifiers, however, are not hard and fast rules for how groups could be differentiated; nearly two-thirds of the criminal groups analyzed in the 2021 SOCTA were composed of members of different nationalities.
