

0.1. **Sociologists in Complexity Science** The first example comes from the new science of networks (Barabasi 2003). By now most readers are familiar with the phenomena known as six degrees of separation, the idea that because most large networks are comprised of a significant number of non-random weak ties, the nodes (e.g., people, companies, etc.)
