Considerations for palpating the abdomen	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Avoid touching tender or painful areas until last and measure the client's vital signs.• Perform light palpation before deep palpation to detect tenderness and superficial masses.• Keep in mind that the normal abdomen may be tender, especially in the areas over the spleen (penosa, liver), some lower pole of the kidneys, gas filled stomach, intestinal colic, etc.	Palpating abdomen <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Perform light palpation: apices, 1 cm deep• Deeply palpate all quadrants to determine abdominal mass, subtle masses: apices, 3-4 cm deep• Palpate for masses• Palpate the umbilicus and surrounding area for tenderness, or masses.• Palpate:<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Aortao Livero Spleeno Kidneyso Urinary bladder (not best able) 	Other adult considerations <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tenderness in pain at the costochondral junction of ribs is seen with rheumatism, especially in older clients with osteoporosis.• Older adults may experience dyspnea with various activities related to aging of lungs (Loss of elasticity, Arterio-sclerotic capillaries, loss of surfactant)• Chest pain related to pleuritis may be absent in older people cause of age-related alterations.• Ability to cough effectively may decrease because of weaker muscles and movement rigidity on thoracic wall.• Deep breathing may be difficult when are fatigued easily• It's difficult to converse in older yrs.• Older yrs. Thoracic response is decreased due to calcification of costal cartilage and loss of accessory movements.• The apices and ribs may be more prominent in older clients because of loss of subcutaneous fat.
