Axial Muscles

MUSCLES OF THE THORAX

External intercostal
 - lies deep, posterior to external intercostal
 - flexes rib posteriorly & inferiorly
 - inspiration

Internal intercostal

- most superficial intercostal muscle
 - flexes rib anteriorly & inferiorly
 - expiring between ribs
 - rib inspiration



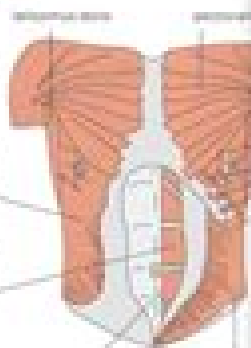
MUSCLES OF THE ABDOMEN

External oblique
 - most superficial of anterolateral abdominal wall
 - flexes hip anteriorly & inferiorly
 - lateral flexion

Internal oblique
 flexes vertebral column & compresses abdominal wall used in forced expiration

Transverse abdominis
 spinal flexion & rotation around vertebral column

Rectus abdominis
 - lies on either side of linea alba
 - separated by tendinous intersections
 - functions to flex trunk & aids in forced expiration



Linea alba
 - line of connective tissue down middle of abdomen for muscle attachment

Axial Muscles

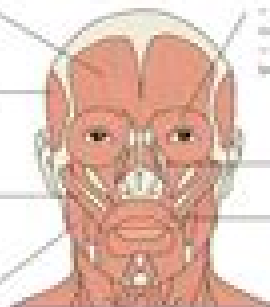
Levator palmarum
 - elevates hand causing flexion of wrist

Depressor
 - extends from hyoid bone to parathyroid gland to connective process of hyoid bone
 - elevates & adducts mandible posteriorly

Suprahyoid
 - extends from hyoid bone to anterior arch of hyoid bone
 - elevates & protrudes mandible anteriorly

Masseter
 - powerful muscle descending from zygomatic arch to angle of mandible
 - elevates & protrudes jaw anteriorly for chewing

FACIAL & NECK MUSCLES



Orbicularis oculi
 - surrounds eye
 - forcibly closes eyes when contracted
 - originates on frontal & maxillary foramina

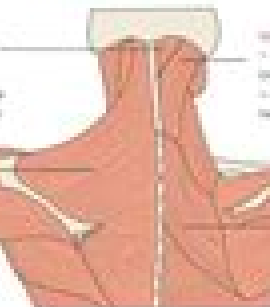
Orbicularis oris
 - surrounds mouth
 - elevates & protrudes lip
 - originates on maxillary & mandibular foramina

Platysma
 - extends from clavicle to mandible
 - elevates & protrudes jaw anteriorly for chewing

NECK & BACK MUSCLES

Longus capitis
 - extends from anterior tubercle of atlas to posterior tubercle of atlas
 - tenses back slightly to assist with cervical contraction

Longus colli
 - stabilizes & moves the hyoid
 - extends vertically from hyoid bone to lower thoracic vertebrae of the spine



Longus cervicis
 - extends from anterior tubercle of atlas to posterior tubercle of atlas
 - tenses back & assists with cervical contraction

Longus thoracis
 - extends the scapula into the thorax
 - helps move scapula superiorly & medially

Lower Limb Muscles

Quick notes:

In correct anatomical terms, "leg" only refers to the region of the lower limb below the knee, while "thigh" refers to the region from the knee to the hip

POSTERIOR THIGH & LEG MUSCLES

Gluteus maximus
 - extends thigh
 - deep to gluteus medius

Gluteus medius
 - extends thigh

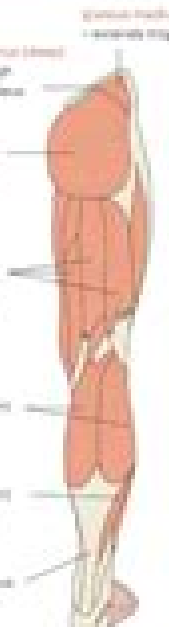
Hamstrings
 - extends hip
 - flexes knee

Peroneus
 - flexes foot (plantar flexion)
 - supinated to extend

Gastrocnemius
 - flexes foot (plantar flexion)
 - deep to peroneus

Soleus
 - flexes foot (plantar flexion)
 - deep to gastrocnemius

Plantar flexion
 - gastrocnemius & soleus work together to flex foot/leg
