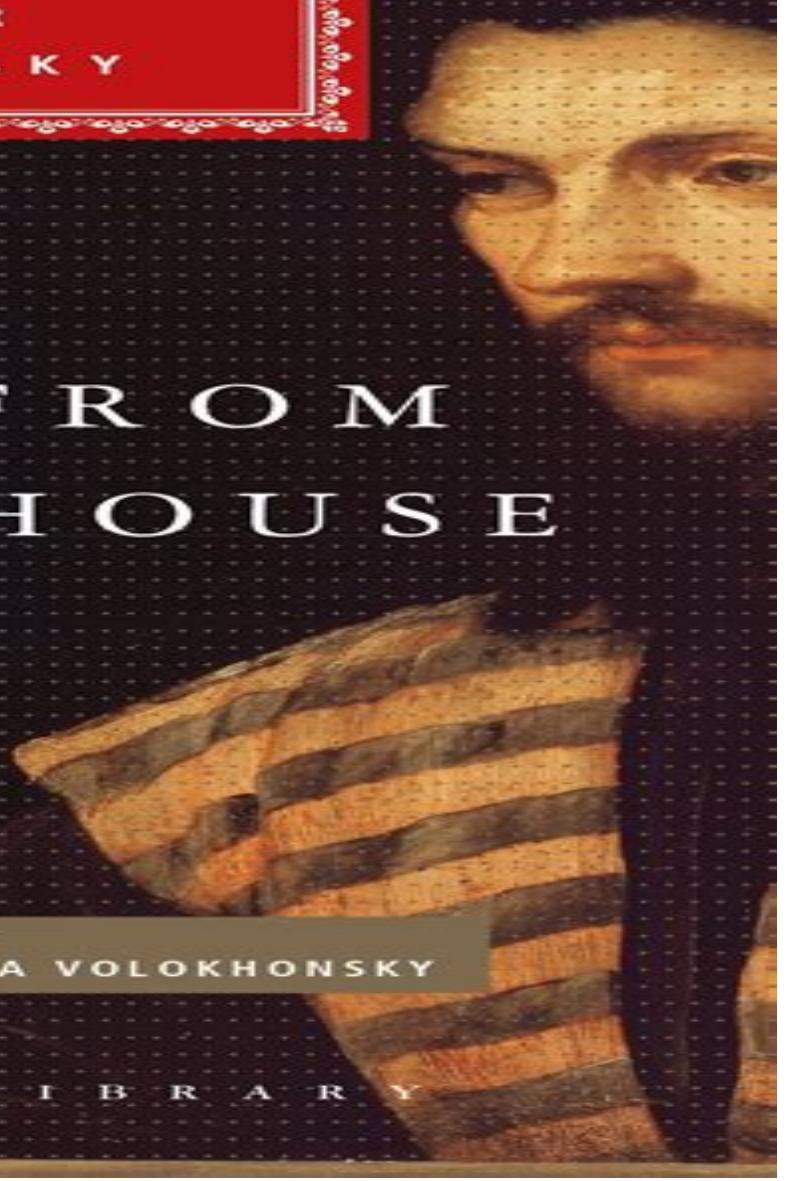

The four years he spent there startlingly recreated in *The House of the Dead* were the most agonizing of his life. In this fictionalized account he recounts his soul destroying incarceration through the cool detached tones of his narrator Aleksandr Petrovich Goryanchikov the daily battle for survival the wooden plank beds the cabbage soup swimming with cockroaches his strange family of boastful ugly cruel convicts. Yet *The House of the Dead* is far more than a work of documentary realism it is also a powerful novel of redemption describing one man's spiritual and moral death and the miracle of his gradual reawakening.

In 1849 Dostoevsky was sentenced to four years at hard labor in a Siberian prison camp for his participation in a utopian socialist discussion group. The account he wrote after his release based on notes he smuggled out was the first book to reveal life inside the Russian penal system. The book not only brought him fame but also founded the tradition of Russian prison writing. *Notes from a Dead House* sometimes translated as *The House of the Dead* is filled with vivid details of brutal punishments shocking conditions feuds and betrayals and the psychological effects of the loss of freedom but it also describes moments of comedy and acts of kindness. There are grotesque bathhouse and hospital scenes that seem to have come straight from Dante's *Inferno* alongside daring escape attempts doomed acts of defiance and a theatrical Christmas celebration that draws the entire community together in a temporary suspension of their grim reality. To get past government censors Dostoevsky made his narrator a common law criminal rather than a political prisoner but the perspective is unmistakably his own. His incarceration was a transformative experience that nourished all his later works particularly *Crime and Punishment*. Dostoevsky's narrator discovers that even among the most debased criminals there are strong and beautiful souls. His story reveals the prison as a tragedy both for the inmates and for Russia it is finally a profound meditation on freedom. The prisoner himself knows that he is a prisoner but no brands no fetters will make him forget that he is a human being.

Redemption and the Merchant God Susan McReynolds Oddo, 2008 Dostoyevsky's antisemitism manifested in his writings of the 1870s seems to contradict his humanism and many critics have tended to dismiss it as a marginal detail of the writer's views. Argues however that antisemitism held an important place in Dostoyevsky's ethical system and was linked to his vexed relationship with Christianity. Notes that he staunchly held three ethical principles sanctity of children incompatibility of ethics with utilitarianism and calculation and the view that every kind of authority was bound by the same moral strictures as individuals. Thus he could not accept a God who had sacrificed his son or a redemption brought about by the suffering of a child Jesus. Dostoyevsky invented the image of a Jew onto whom he could project

everything that was unacceptable to him in religion and Western ethics. He considered the merchant ethics of both liberalism and socialism to be a Jewish idea and in particular regarded the politics of the Jew Disraeli as an embodiment of such ethics to sacrifice innocent Balkan Slavs in the name of supreme political principles. In the 1870s Dostoyevsky increasingly contrasted the Russian conception of God and compassion for the weak with the Jewish Western merchant God and the idea of obtaining benefits for one person from the suffering of another innocent person. He developed a conception of principal opposition between things Russian and things Jewish.

A connoisseur of the troubled human psyche and the relationships between the individuals, Dostoevsky's oeuvre covers a large area of subjects: politics, religion, social issues, philosophy and the uncharted realms of the psychological. There have been at least 30 film and TV adaptations of Fyodor Dostoevsky's 1866 novel *Crime and Punishment*, with probably the most popular being the British BBC TV series starring John Simm as Raskolnikov and Ian McDiarmid as Porfiry Petrovich. *The Idiot* has also been adapted for films and TV, as well as *Demons* and *The Brothers Karamazov*.

fiction But when it is foregrounded in works of literature it is not only the most dramatic way of representing human suffering it is also used to explore in the most intense form existential questions regarding the meaning of human existence and the justice of the universe Perhaps it is not entirely coincidental then that imaginative works about physical pain though few in number figure prominently among the masterpieces of the western literary tradition The best were written during two of the west s most astonishing periods of literary creativity fifth century BC Athens and nineteenth century Russia and by the most prominent artists of their time Prometheus Bound by Aeschylus The Women of Trachis and Philoctetes by Sophocles Notes from the House of the Dead by Dostoevsky and The Death of Ivan Illyich and War and Peace by Tolstoy In all these works physical pain is always portrayed as a dynamic process that includes the view point of the victim the perpetrator much of the physical pain is in the form of torture and the onlooker or witness In the Greek works physical pain is the main vehicle for exposing the injustice of the gods and the world order and in the Russian works for questioning the moral legitimacy of the state In Prometheus Bound Zeus delegitimizes his rule by torturing Prometheus for his service to mankind In The Women of Trachis the gods look indifferently upon the excruciating suffering of Hercules the greatest Greek hero In Philoctetes the gods cruelly exploit the terrible pain of the hero as a means of winning victory at Troy for their Greek wards In the Russian works the mechanisms for inflicting the maximum amount of physical pain during corporal punishment undermine the moral foundations of the state and argue for its dissolution Though the Greek and Russian works are separated by genre plays vs novels and by time over two thousand years they are united by the way they employ pain to investigate the justice or rather injustice of the world order
