of these last eight nights in the dark, when Holmes emerges an Impresario, a "young older", (which has been added by Shetford above in script) and the Shetford that it could drink, talk and respond to a rebuff.) The final of these little addendums to the English manuscript is a sentence written from the story, which was first published in the *Strand* for February 1892.

The Adventure of the Engineer's Thumb. Doyle becomes inventively generous in this tale, beginning it in Watson's narrating voice as he (incongruously) reads an impression. Then the police -- Miss Flanagan, whose profession of engineer was just the new thing for a man, practical young man in the 1890's -- tells the story of how he lost his thumb to a man player, and Holmes identifies the crime and the criminal for whom the attack on Flanagan was a mere incident. The story was first published in the *Strand* for March 1892.

The Adventure of the Noble Bachelor. One can hear an echo of Doyle's early verbal and narrative style in this story, which first appeared in the *Strand* for April 1892. The title is a comedy, for there is no acknowledged Bachelor in the story. At its center is a railway robbery; in the background, events are but an excuse that took place in the American west. Holmes, coming out to share the American impression of Artemus as nervous, speaks of the famous "quarantine of the Union Jack, with its stars and stripes" in his hope for publication. The story includes such other historical details as Holmes's search of a scaffold when suspecting that the detective has not worked in such a moral field before ("No, I am descending") and the arrival of "telegrams and newspaper letters" at a newspaper's editorial office at 221B Baker Street.

The Adventure of the Beryl Coronet. Unusual for being an adult story, this tale -- which first appeared in the *Strand* for May 1892 -- is one of several great cliff-hangers in the early Canon. It also has a going visual subplot, and brings Holmes into direct contact with one of those mysterious quasi-royal personages who also figure in several of the tales. Here guessing it is for any such personage to possess such property (with a most respectable history) the person who, and here guessing it is for a person to knock off such a coronet with an audited crack, it may be best for the reader not to suspect.

The Adventure of the Copper Beeches. This account of the "haunted in the trees" tales, published in the *Strand* for June 1892, presents the first of the "Four Valleys", written -- more or less dictated -- after those that give name and appear in Holmes's tales. Valley Queen, the greatest peasant about a forest-belt where she is compelled to run off her beautiful red hair, is in fact a strikingly strong and interesting woman, whose actions have sometimes inspired in a socialist name for Holmes. The name is an abominable pun on the "Fuchs-

A total series of twelve "Adventures of Sherlock Holmes", as they were first called, appeared in the *Strand* beginning in December 1890 and continuing through September 1891. Again, the American edition of the *Strand* called them a month later, and they also appeared shortly afterwards in *Staple's Weekly* except for "The Final Problem", which was published in *McClure's* as well as in the *Strand*.

As soon as the series was complete, it was published in book form as *The Memoirs of Sherlock Holmes*. The first American edition, from Harper & Brothers, contains all twelve of the 1890-1891 stories, but the first British edition, from George Newnes, Ltd., omits "The Cardboard Box", which was then dropped from all subsequent book editions of *The Memoirs*, including a "boxed issue" from Harper in September 1891.

The Adventure of Silver Bells has against the irresistibly colorful background of horse-racing, and provided with some of the more dramatic dialogue anywhere in the Canon, this story is a favorite and has been dramatized often. It provides the "ring" in the epithet "silver bells", which is an otherwise common in the more frequently quoted of Holmes's sayings, and for Shetford it is provided the racing mathematical puzzle of the two whose speed Holmes could calculate to the nearest one-half mile per hour, as well as many interesting anomalies in the details of racing entries and regulations. Further, in the original publication, it provides the most popular of all Sidney Paget illustrations, showing Holmes and Watson in their railway carriage, in classic pose. The story, first published in the *Strand* for December 1890, and reprinted in *Staple's Weekly* for February 21, 1891, has a surprise ending of a kind that could hardly be improved upon.

The Adventure of the Cardboard Box. First published in the *Strand* for January 1891, and *Staple's Weekly* for January 14 of that year, this story requires the detective work and a very satisfactory conclusion. It also features a double murder (the shooting of the victim's son, a simulation of the kind Doyle used again and again in his writings, is particularly gruesome) and was much-quoted by serial publishers. Presumably for such reasons, Doyle chose to suppress the story soon after its publication, and to remove it for twenty-three years. He told an acquaintance in 1920 that "a late writing was never of place in a collection designed for boys." (Later he called it "immature" and (which it is not) "vile".) It may well be that his real reason for suppressing the story was to prevent, under this defensive status, a bad ending like a happy ending.
