



Neonatal Resuscitation Program, 8th edition- Algorithm

The most important and effective action in neonatal resuscitation is ventilation of the baby's lungs.



Ventilation Corrective Steps (NRP/SCPA)

When a NRP/SCPA step results in chest movement, ventilate for 30 seconds and reassess heart rate.



Increase pressure incrementally by 1 to 5 cm H2O. The maximum recommended pressure is 40 cm H2O in term baby.
