

His incarceration was a transformative experience that nourished all his later works particularly *Crime and Punishment*. Dostoevsky's narrator discovers that even among the most debased criminals there are strong and beautiful souls. His story reveals the prison as a tragedy both for the inmates and for Russia it is finally a profound meditation on freedom. The prisoner himself knows that he is a prisoner but no brands, no fetters will make him forget that he is a human being.
