OOIS'94 Dilip Patel, Yuan Sun, Shushma Patel, 2012-12-06 This volume contains the papers presented at the International Conference on Object Oriented Information Systems OOIS 94 held at South Bank University London December 19-21 1994. In response to our call for papers a total 85 papers from 24 different countries were submitted. Each paper was evaluated by at least two Program Committee members and an additional reviewer. Together we selected 41 papers for presentation at the conference and inclusion in the Proceedings. Also included are the keynote addresses by Peter Gray and Michael Jackson. The other submissions were recommended for presentation in the poster sessions.
