Several of its essays have never been published before. Most of the rest though previously published have been updated and otherwise revised sometimes heavily. Topics include theological diversity, symbiosis between theology and genre criticism, pre-Papian tradition concerning Mark and Matthew as apostolically Johannine, Secret Mark as secondary, mishnaic jurisprudence as compatible with Jesus' blasphemy, Matthew as not Christian Jewish Matthean soteriology, criticism of H D Betz on the Sermon on the Mount P Oxy 655 as secondary to Q 12 22b 31, resurrection as uniformly physical, criticism of nonreductive physicalism, criticism of the new perspective on Paul's nonimputation of Christ's righteousness, puberal sexual lusts in Romans 7 7-25 cruciform rather than incarnational emphasis in Philippians 2 6-11, Thessalonian eschatology, John's sectarianism, the pervasiveness of John's Word Christology, Revelation's angelomorphic Christology and the New Jerusalem.
